

## **How Corporate Media Protects Globalists Like Biden**







By following the evolution of this propaganda in the most prestigious scholarly journal in the world, *Foreign Affairs*, anyone can determine years in advance what the future defense and foreign policies of the United States will be. If a certain proposition is repeated often enough in that journal, then the US administration in power - be it Republican or Democrat - begins to act as if that proposition or assumption were in established fact."

The CFR and related globalist organizations let the media know what it is they can report on and they follow suit with the understanding that compliance means career advancement and refusal means your journalism career will be limited to writing obituaries in a 10<sup>th</sup> tier media market.



This brings us to the globalists and their current protection plan over the usurper in chief Joe Biden.

## 2nd local radio host says they were given questions ahead of Biden interview

"Yes, I was given some questions for Biden," Earl Ingram told ABC News.

Biden: 'I don't think anybody's more qualified to be president'
ABC News' George Stephanopoulos interviews President Joe Biden on "This Week."

A second local radio host on Saturday told ABC News that he was provided a list of questions in advance of his interview with President <u>Joe Biden</u> this week.

Consider the words of a member of the media who seems to be completely ignorant of journalistic integrity:

"Yes, I was given some questions for Biden," Earl Ingram of CivicMedia told ABC News. Ingram, a prominent host of a <u>Wisconsin</u> radio station, interviewed Biden this week in the wake of his debate performance.

Ingram said he was given five questions and ended up asking four of them.

"I didn't get a chance to ask him all the things I wanted to ask," he said.

Ingram told ABC he didn't see anything necessarily wrong with the practice. "To think that I was gonna get an opportunity to ask any question to the President of the United States, I think, is a bit more than anybody should expect," he said.

He continued that he was grateful for the opportunity to interview Biden at all.

"Certainly the fact that they gave me this opportunity ... meant a lot to me," Ingram said.

So called members of the media are more concerned about the positive personal financial impact of covering for Biden than they are in revealing the truth of who and what he is.

Comments from the Biden administration on this topic would be comical if the reality of the situation was not so dire and impactful. For the Biden staff tried to play off the scandal as "business as usual" (which it certainly is) but promised not to do it again, as Continued CNN:

"A Biden campaign spokesperson on Saturday did not deny that the campaign provided questions but said that "We do not condition interviews on acceptance of these questions."

"It's not at all an uncommon practice for interviewees to share topics they would prefer. These questions were relevant to the news of the day—the president was asked about this debate performance as well as what he'd delivered for black Americans," spokesperson Lauren Hitt said in a statement.

The Biden campaign said later Saturday it will no longer suggest questions to interviewers."
