Without Fair Elections, We Do Not Have a Free Country

It's long past time to restore America's election integrity.

The security of the United States' election system has been incrementally deteriorating for years. Democrats **AND** Republicans have supported an increasing number of measures over time in the name of making voting more accessible and "fair." These measures, including a slew of mail-in options and secretive counting processes, have made elections more vulnerable to fraud than they've ever been.

This legislation is obviously pro-Globalist and Anti-American because it compromises the integrity of our elections, opening the door to fraudulent behavior, which drives people to lose faith in our elections. Measures such as drop boxes and early voting must be fully opposed.
